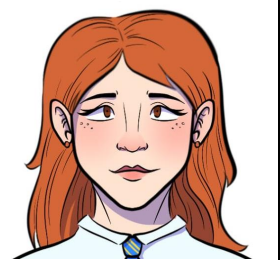
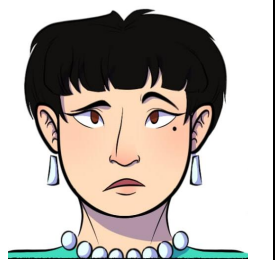


Printing instructions (you don't need to print this page!)

Continue along Crescent Road past Hales Bar, looking out for this feature on the left. Cross carefully to it.

Location 8: Take a look around the sculpture and find a number for each of the following to put together the year of birth of one of the innocent suspects:

- 1) The number on the highlighted lamp post
- 2) The number of sides on the platform below the statue
- 3) The number of information boards surrounding the statue
- 4) The number of benches around the sculpture



A bit of a walk to the next suspect...Cross back over and continue along Crescent Road, passing Royal Baths Chinese restaurant on your right. Cross over Parliament St and onto Kings Road before turning right up Cheltenham Crescent and continue straight up the hill onto Cheltenham Parade. Carry on past the theatre and bear right at the Oxford Street corner.



As you turn on to Oxford Street, keep an eye out for this key image...

Location 9: The person you can rule out here could *make* the keys for us – not take them!

Continue along onto Oxford St pedestrianised area, then left at Games Crusade

Location 10: To continue your mission, head up Cambridge Place, Look up for the letters to help you solve this case. Once you have found them, pay attention to the details, For a name is spelled out with Flowers-Shopping Restaurant-Theatre-Dales

At the top of Cambridge Place, head left towards Station Parade. At the end, turn right and look out for the Jubilee Monument at Station Square

Location 11: The suspect who laid the foundation stone of this memorial was far too honourable to steal our puzzles

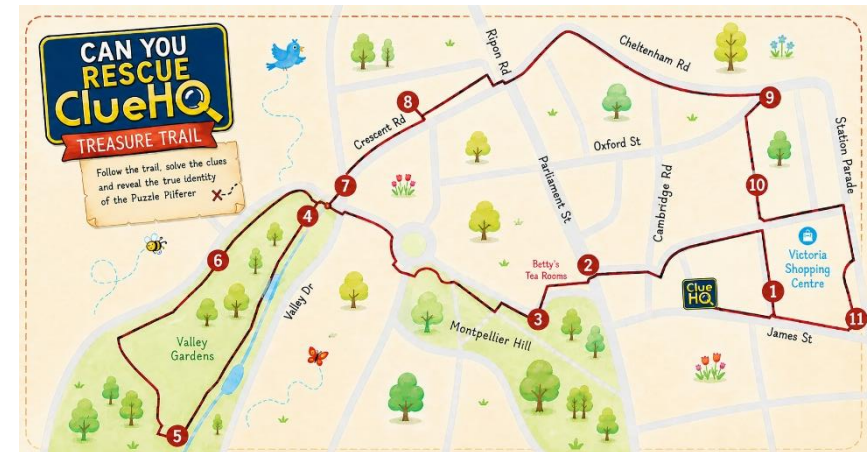

Can you Rescue Clue HQ?

We have received intelligence that the notorious ‘Puzzle Pincher’ is planning a heist to steal the puzzles from Clue HQ Harrogate. Detective Cody Breaker has shortlisted 12 suspects. Uncover the sneaky thief’s true identity so we can stop them before all of our puzzles are gone!

The clues at each location will help you to identify one innocent suspect by name, description or year of birth (some of them are now *really* old!!). Write the number of the location where you ruled them out in the box next to their name until only the culprit remains.

Starting on Prospect crescent with Clue HQ on your right, go the short distance to James St and head left to Accessorize. Left again then pause and look around for your Location 1 clue.

Location 1: Despite being a rather angry man, this suspect is resting by a viaduct, surrounded by green hills and nature. He's not our Pilferer.

Continue into the pedestrianised area, turning left at Bakery Café. Pass the Cenotaph and cross to Betty's tea rooms.

Location 2: Detective Cody Breaker's door-to-door enquiries found no evidence that the person living at the address of the first Betty's Tea Rooms was planning to capture our clues!

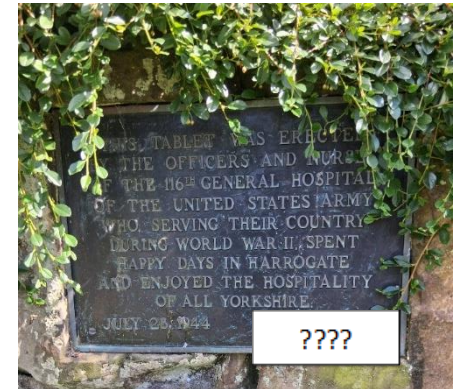


A short distance down the hill, keep an eye out for your 3rd clue pictured on the left

Location 3: She saw this tree being carved, aged 34 at the time, Now too busy on her bike to plot any Clue HQ crime.

Cross the road and head right down Montpelier Hill. Pass The Crown Hotel, around Royal Parade and into Valley Gardens. Look out for the plaque on your left shortly after the entrance

Location 4: The person born 23 years after the United States army left Harrogate isn't planning to sabotage Clue HQ.



Follow the low path along the stream in Valley Gardens to the Magnesia Well Cafe.

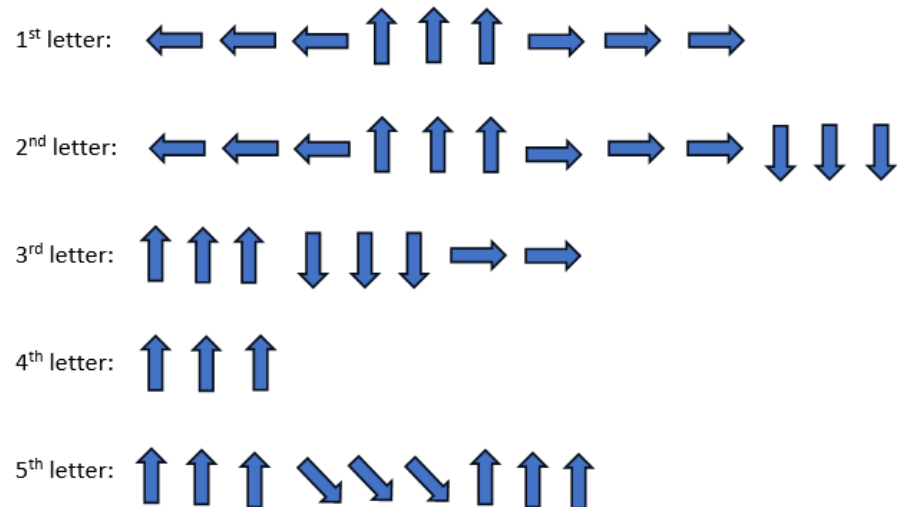
Location 5: Detective Cody was asking for any information at the MAGNESIA WELL CAFE but it seems his evidence got a little scrambled!

Continue a few metres past the café, then turn right to take the fence-lined path up the hill signed 'Telephones'. Bear right into the Sun Pavilions walkway at the top. Location 6 clue can be solved using any of the paving squares in this area.

Location 6: No need to look up, there are no clues to be found,
All you will need is your feet and the ground.
Pick a place to start and from there you will travel,
Using the squares on the floor, the shape of 5 letters will
unravel.

1 arrow = move 1 square

Make sure you face the same way throughout.



Continue to the end of the walkway and back out of Valley Gardens. Head
over the zebra crossing to the Royal Pump Room
